A NEW ENTERTAINMENT ERA BEGINS AT DEERHURST RESORT

For almost as long as the resort has produced its own stage show, it has also showcased headliner acts including Jann Arden, Jim Cuddy, Burton Cummings, Trooper and many other household names that have attracted wide audiences to the resort. The decision to focus on a series of shows rather than a single core production was made to provide a variety of entertainment experiences to attract broader markets, especially during shoulder seasons.
