Guests will swing, stride and climb throughout the treetops using zip lines, ropes, bridges and climbing nets. The spectacular Tarzan swing will bring out the inner Tarzan or Jane in any participant as they swing high above the park for all to see.

“Treetop Trekking makes an incredible addition to the four seasons of activities that Deerhurst Resort offers guests and the public,” says Chris Lund, General Manager of Deerhurst Resort. “We certainly think it will bring out the kid in anyone!”

For an unforgettable experience, visitors have the option to explore Muskoka at night with guided Treetop Trekking night treks, beginning at dusk. Both guests and the public are welcome to experience the adventure.

Operated by Arbraska, the new Deerhurst location will be the third Treetop Trekking adventure park in Ontario and will complement the existing park at [Skyline Hotels & Resorts](#)’ sister property, [Horseshoe Resort](#). Arbraska has three additional locations in Quebec.
